Residency Appeals Request

If a student's application for Nevada Residency is denied, the student has 30 days from the date of denial to submit an appeal. All appeals are due the Friday before the start of the subsequent term. Appeals submitted after this date will still be considered, but only for the subsequent term.

There is a rebuttable presumption that a nonresident attending an institution of the Nevada System of Higher Education is in the State of Nevada for the primary or sole purpose of obtaining an education. Therefore, a nonresident who enrolls in an institution of the System shall continue to be classified as a nonresident student throughout the student's enrollment, unless and until the student demonstrates that his or her previous residence has been abandoned and that the student is a Nevada resident. A student seeking reclassification to resident status must submit the Nevada Residency Reclassification Application, sign the Declaration of Residency, and provide the documentation requested on the application that supports the claim of bona fide residency in Nevada, and intent to remain in Nevada.
