legislative session. A potential special session of the legislation could occur during the summer, possibly to address the 3rd federal stimulus package distribution or any items not concluded during the current session.

- o NSHE budget review will close on May 6th, 2021.
- o Revenue actuals have come in higher that expected. The Economic Forum will meet again to discuss NSHE and K-12 capital improvements, which includes GBC ¶ welding lab.
- o Bills considered during this legislative session that pertain to GBC and NSHE are:
 - f AB384 Title IX
 - f AB450 Provides for the review of certain administrative regulations by the Legislature.
 (BDR 18-929).
 - f AB416 Directs the Legislative Auditor to conduct audits of the Nevada System of Higher Education. (BDR S-753)
 - f AB319 Establishes a pilot program relating to dual credit courses. (BDR S-925)
 - f Alternate FAFSA Bill
 - f SB321- Creates the Nevada System of Community Colleges. (BDR 34-905). This bill died but could be addressed as an addition to another bill.
- x There will be a special Board of Regents meeting today, 4/16/21. GBC President Joyce Helens will submit GBC ¶ Annual Metrics Presentation to the Board.
